## **PreQual – Final Conference and Handbook Presentation in Greece**

Pre-Qualification for Migrant Women in the Health and Care Sectors (PreQual) is a collaborative project of 6 European countries (Austria, Germany, Italy, Greece, Bulgaria and Spain) whose main aim is to support migrant women in the health and care sector. The PreQual project intends to match the labour market needs with those of migrant women and to provide a future-oriented and innovative solution.

On Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> of March 2007, in Thessaloniki, Greece a dissemination conference is organised, where participants will be informed about the all outcomes of the PreQual project. There will also be the opportunity to discuss about the project and to participate in the “Theatre of the Oppressed”, a political theatrical form originally used in radical popular education movements, growing up alongside Paulo Freire's Pedagogy of the Oppressed. The handbook with the final curriculum of the qualification course for migrant women who wish to enter the health and care field has been formed and is being published, and will be presented in the final conference of the PreQual project. It will serve as learning and teaching material. The handbook will include a detailed description of the contents of the curriculum to be supplemented by instructions on methodology, learning material, material for self-study and further literature.

Since October 2004 the work of PreQual has been taking place, and in March 2007 it is reaching its closing point.
